

MEDICAL EMERGENCY ATTENDANT

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision, incumbents assist with providing emergency medical assessment and treatment when required for patients in need of care. Incumbents may be assigned to any location in the county to provide standby and perform patient care services as needed. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Administers appropriate emergency care/first aid treatment in accordance with established New York State Bureau of Emergency Services and Westchester Regional EMS protocols and procedures;

Assists with the stabilization, extrication and movement of patients;

May assist in the transportation of patients as needed;

Obtains information related to patients for departmental records, completes forms and reports, including electronic prehospital care reports (ePCR), as needed;

Assists in obtaining staffing, maintaining equipment and assuring supply levels are adequate.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of prehospital emergency care; knowledge of patient care and transportation techniques; ability to assess emergency situations and decide on an required actions necessary; ability to work well with the public and other health care professionals; ability to move patients without endangering them or self; courtesy; neat appearance; good judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: High school or equivalency diploma and six months experience in providing emergency patient care in a hospital, volunteer or paid agency as a certified emergency medical technician or paramedic.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Possess and maintain a valid Emergency Medical Technician Certificate issued by the New York State Department of Health, while in the title.
