

SENIOR ATTENDANT - PLAYLAND

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision, an incumbent is responsible for insuring that refreshment stands are properly staffed during operations and closed at the appropriate time. During the off-season, an employee in this position manages the refreshment stand at the hockey rink. Supervision is exercised over a substantial number of seasonal employees. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Inspects refreshment stand personnel for appropriate dress and cleanliness;

Insures that all stands are adequately staffed;

Gives relief to stand in very busy periods;

Lends assistance to stands in very busy periods;

Inventories stock at each stand daily;

Closes stands and sees that all cash receipts are taken to the cashier;

Manages the refreshment stand at the hockey rink in the winter season.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of refreshment stand operations; good knowledge of simple food preparation and cooking; ability to provide partial supervision over others; ability to make change rapidly and accurately; ability to get along with coworkers and public; courtesy; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Completion of two years of high school and two seasons work experience.

NOTE: The Season at Playland is 3 months, therefore, a summer job is considered equal to one season.
