

PARKING METER REPAIRER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Incumbents of this class perform routine mechanical work consisting of the maintenance and repair of municipal parking meters. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Inspects meters reported defective by police;

Repairs, replaces, and cleans meters;

Maintains stock of meter parts;

Removes and repairs broken meter posts;

Paints meters and posts;

Collects money from parking meters.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Mechanical aptitude; ability to understand oral and written directions; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Either (a) graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and one year of experience that involved the operation, maintenance, or repair of mechanical equipment; or (b) five years of experience as specified in (a) above.

NOTE: Unless otherwise noted, only experience gained after attaining the minimum education level indicated in the minimum qualifications will be considered in evaluating experience.
