

POLICE SURGEON
(Part-Time)

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs professional medical services as a part-time physician on twenty-four hour call; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is responsible professional work calling for the services of an experienced physician. The position carries no supervisory responsibilities.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Reports to accident sites when called by Police Department;

Examines prisoners at Police Headquarters for medical problems or in the event of a medical emergency;

Performs physical examinations on victims of sexual assault on behalf of Police Department;

Treats all Workers Compensation cases.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of the principles and practices of medicine; ability to get along well with others; conscientiousness and thoroughness; interest in maintaining a high standard of public service; good professional judgment; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Graduation from a school of medicine of recognized standing and experience as a physician or surgeon sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT: Possession of a valid license to practice medicine in New York State.
